This charter forms part of the <u>Club's Welfare Policy</u> which is a condition of membership and the participation at club events by families and guests. All members, both playing and non-playing, are asked and expected to:

- Avoid criticism of umpires' judgement in public, particularly on social media.
- Recognise and encourage fair play and applaud good performances of both sides.
- Respect that the club has zero tolerance of the use of drugs.
- Support the club's determination to be inclusive of all and understand that the club will have a zero tolerance of any racist language or behaviour or abuse, particularly if it is based on a person's gender, sexual orientation, religion or belief, age or disability.
- Consider wellbeing and safety of self and others before performance.
- Speak, in confidence, to the Club Safeguarding Officer/Club Chair if you have any concerns or are having difficulty affording match fees or subscription.
